Carole Taylor began her career as a journalist, working for both CTV and CBC over the years. In 1986 she was elected as an Alderman for the City of Vancouver. After two terms at the municipal level she served as the Chair of the Vancouver Port and then as the Chair of the Canada Ports Corporation. In 2001, Ms. Taylor became the Chair of the Board of CBC/Radio-Canada. In 2005, she successfully ran for provincial office, and was subsequently appointed as the British Columbia Minister of Finance. In 2008 stepped aside from provincial politics, and was subsequently named by federal Finance Minister Jim Flaherty as the Chair of his Economic Advisory Council.

More recently she has co-chaired the Business Council of British Columbia's Outlook 2020 Summit Series and has accepted the position of senior adviser in the Vancouver office of Borden Ladner Gervais. She has also been appointed to the Board of Directors of TD Bank Financial Group.
